SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF THE BID

1. SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

Tenders will be opened in public immediately after the advertised closing date. Submissions must be in a sealed envelope clearly marked as per instruction on page 5 of the tender document (advert).

2. TENDER DEPOSIT

It is compulsory that service providers download a copy of the bid document that will <u>ONLY</u> be available as from 6 September 2018 on the following website: <u>www.mbombela.gov.za</u> and <u>www.etenders.gov.za</u> on the tenders and notices folder, free of charge.

3. ADJUDICATION OF TENDER

The City of Mbombela will not be bound to accept the lowest or any tender and also reserves the right to cancel the tender when deemed necessary.

The tender will be adjudicated by City of Mbombela in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, no. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of bid in the bid document, read in conjunction with the preferential procurement regulations, 2017, where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE status level of contribution.

The contract period is for 36 (thirty six) months after the final adjudication of bid and signing of contract. The successful bidder will be expected to enter into a contract where a Service Level Agreement (SLA) will be signed by the successful bidder and the employer after contract award and acceptance. Terms and condition will be reflected in the SLA including penalties.

It is compulsory to attach references from previous clients on similar or related projects.

4. COMPLETION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

Tenders will only be considered on receipt of this tender document correctly completed with all insertions in black ink and signed.

The following **compulsory** documentation **must** be attached in order for the bid to be considered:

5. BRIEFING SESSION

6. TAXES AND DUTIES PAYABLE

Bidders shall allow in their tenders for the payment and recovery of all taxes and other duties. No claims for additional payment in this respect will be considered. Prices and rates quoted shall be inclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT). VAT shall be recorded as a lump sum in the tender summary and the total inclusive of VAT carried to the Form of Tender.

7. WITHDRAWAL OF TENDER

In the event of the successful tender failing to execute the service in terms of this tender, the Municipality shall be entitled to cancel the contract summarily, in which event the Bidder shall be liable for any additional expense incurred by reason of the Municipality having to call for fresh tenders or having to accept any less favourable tender.

8. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF TENDERS

The period of validity of tenders shall be **90** days as stated in the tender form and be calculated from the closing date for submission of tenders.

9. NOTICE OF BIDDERS

Should any additions or alterations to the document as issued to Bidders be deemed necessary prior to the date for submission of tenders, they will be issued to Bidders in the form of Notices and will form part of the tender document.

The Notices to Bidders shall be completed where applicable by Bidders, signed, dated and returned with the tender documents.

Council will appoint a preferred supplier and a secondary supplier. Should the preferred supplier not be able to deliver as per contract and notify council, as such when an order is placed, the order will be placed for those specific items with the Secondary Supplier.

Should the performance of the Preferred Supplier not be in accordance with the contract and /or either the Preferred Supplier or Council withdraws from the contract, the Secondary Supplier will become the Preferred Supplier.

All products delivered to Council must comply with the specific requirements of SANS, ISO etc.

10. DELIVERABLES

Goods and Services will only be supplied to Council on receipt of an official order issued by Council.
