1. SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

Tenders will be opened in public on the closing date. ALL submission must be sealed in an envelope clearly marked as per instruction on the tender advert (page 5) and failure to adhere to this will render your submission non-responsive.

Prospective bidders are expected to submit two copies of tender documents with all required attachments. The 1st tender document must be original with valid certified copies of the required documents/attachments (clearly marked "ORIGINAL on the front page). 2nd tender document must be a copy of the entire submission packaged exactly as the original submission (clearly marked "COPY on the front page). This condition must be adhered to in order to be considered for further evaluation.

Declaration Certificate for local production and content must be completed in full. Failure to declare or complete the declaration in full will render your bid non responsive.

MBD 1 must be furnished in full and signed. It will further be regarded as a form of offer and failure to adhere to this condition will render your bid non responsive.

It is compulsory for all bidders to attach a resolution letter to give authority to sign for this bid. Failure to adhere to this will lead to immediate disqualification.

2. TENDER DEPOSIT

3. ADJUDICATION OF TENDER

Council does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid, reserves the right to accept the whole or part of any bid and also reserves the right to cancel the bid when deemed necessary.

Council will appoint a panel of service providers to execute this bid.

The tender will be adjudicated by City of Mbombela Municipality in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, no. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of bid in the bid document, read in conjunction with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017, where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE status level of contributor.

4. COMPLETION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

Tenders will only be considered on receipt of this tender document correctly completed with all insertions in black ink and signed.

- CSD report (**summary report is not acceptable**), The CSD report must not be older than 5 days prior the closing date.

5. TAXES AND DUTIES PAYABLE

Bidders shall allow in their tender for the payment and recovery of all taxes and other duties. No claims for additional payment in this respect will be considered. Prices and rates quoted shall be inclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT). VAT shall be recorded as a lump sum in the tender summary and the total inclusive of VAT carried to the Form of Tender.

6. WITHDRAWAL OF TENDER

In the event of the successful tender failing to execute the service in terms of this tender, the Municipality shall be entitled to cancel the contract summarily, in which event the Bidder shall be liable for any additional expense incurred by reason of the Municipality having to call for fresh tenders or having to accept any less favourable tender.

7. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF TENDERS

The period of validity of tenders shall be **90** days as stated in the tender form and be calculated from the closing date for submission of tenders.

8. NOTICE OF BIDDERS

Should any additions or alterations to the document or drawings as issued to Bidders be deemed necessary prior to the date for submission of tenders, these will be issued to Bidders in the form of Notices to Bidders and will form part of the tender document.

The Notices to Bidders shall be completed where applicable by Bidders, signed, dated and returned with the tender documents.

9. DURATION OF CONTRACT DELIVERABLES AND PENALTIES

The contract period is for 36 (thirty-six) months after the final adjudication of bid and signing of contract.

The successful bidder will be expected to enter into a contract where a Service Level Agreement (SLA) will be signed by the successful bidder and the employer after contract award and acceptance. Terms and condition will be reflected in the SLA including penalties.

10. PRICE

Bid prices will be regarded fixed and no additional cost will be added.

Price competitiveness will be evaluated in terms of the rates quoted in the maintenance scenario and new installation table.

All prices must be stated in South African Currency and include Vat. (if applicable).

11. OPERATIONAL CONDITIONS

Breakdown repairs will be logged with Council's elected representatives and the appointed service providers will receive an e-mail detailing the required services, location, contact person and a description of the breakdown/malfunction where possible.

Final rates will be decided prior to contract commencement and a job card must accompany all invoices for breakdown repairs.

Bidders must obtain approval from Council's elected representative before procuring any specialist skills needed to execute any aspects of the contract that may require such expertise.

All service providers must comply with all applicable Health and Safety Act and regulations at own cost and Council is empowered to provide any tools and equipment to the employees of a service provider and invoice the service provider for provision of same.

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1.1 The following preference point systems are applicable to all bids:
- 1.2
- the 80/20 system for requirements with a Rand value of up to R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included); and
- the 90/10 system for requirements with a Rand value above R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included).
- 1.3 The value of this bid is estimated not to exceed R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the 80/20 system shall be applicable.
- 1.4 Preference points for this bid shall be awarded for:
 - (a) Price; and
 - (b) B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution.
- 1.3.1 The maximum points for this bid are allocated as follows:

Total points for Price and B-BBEE must not exceed 100

- Failure on the part of a bidder to fill in and/or to sign this form and submit a B-BBEE Verification Certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by the South African Accreditation System (SANAS) or a Registered Auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors (IRBA) or an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the Close Corporation Act (CCA) together with the bid, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.
- 1.5. The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

- 2.1 "all applicable taxes" includes value-added tax, pay as you earn, income tax, unemployment insurance fund contributions and skills development levies;
- 2.2 **"B-BBEE"** means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad -Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;

- 2.3 **"B-BBEE status level of contributor"** means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based on its overall performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- 2.4 **"bid"** means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of services, works or goods, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- 2.5 **"Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act"** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- 2.6 "**comparative price**" means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts that can be utilized have been taken into consideration;
- 2.7 **"consortium or joint venture"** means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;
- 2.8 "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by an organ of state:
- 2.9 "EME" means any enterprise with annual total revenue of R5 million or less.
- 2.10 "Firm price" means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs or excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;
- 2.11 "functionality" means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.12 "non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- 2.13 "person" includes a juristic person;
- 2.14 **"rand value"** means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;
- 2.15 "sub-contract" means the primary contractor's assigning, leasing, making out work to, or employing, another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;
- 2.16 "total revenue" bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment Act and promulgated in the *Government Gazette* on 9 February 2007;
- 2.17 "**trust**" means the arrangement through which the property of one person is made over or be queathed to a trustee to administer such property for the benefit of another person; and
- 2.18 **"trustee"** means any person, including the founder of a trust, to whom property is bequeathed in order for such property to be administered for the benefit of another person.

3. ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM

- 3.1 The bidder obtaining the highest number of total points will be awarded the contract.
- 3.2 Preference points shall be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking into account all factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts;.
- 3.3 Points scored must be rounded off to the nearest 2 decimal places.
- In the event that two or more bids have scored equal total points, the successful bid must be the one scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful bid must be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.
- 3.6 Should two or more bids be equal in all respects, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

4.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

80/20 or 90/10

$$Ps = 80\left(1 - \frac{Pt - P\min}{P\min}\right)$$
 or $Ps = 90\left(1 - \frac{Pt - P\min}{P\min}\right)$

Where

Ps = Points scored for comparative price of bid under consideration

Pt = Comparative price of bid under consideration

Pmin = Comparative price of lowest acceptable bid

5. Points awarded for B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution

5.1 In terms of Regulation 5 (2) and 6 (2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:
